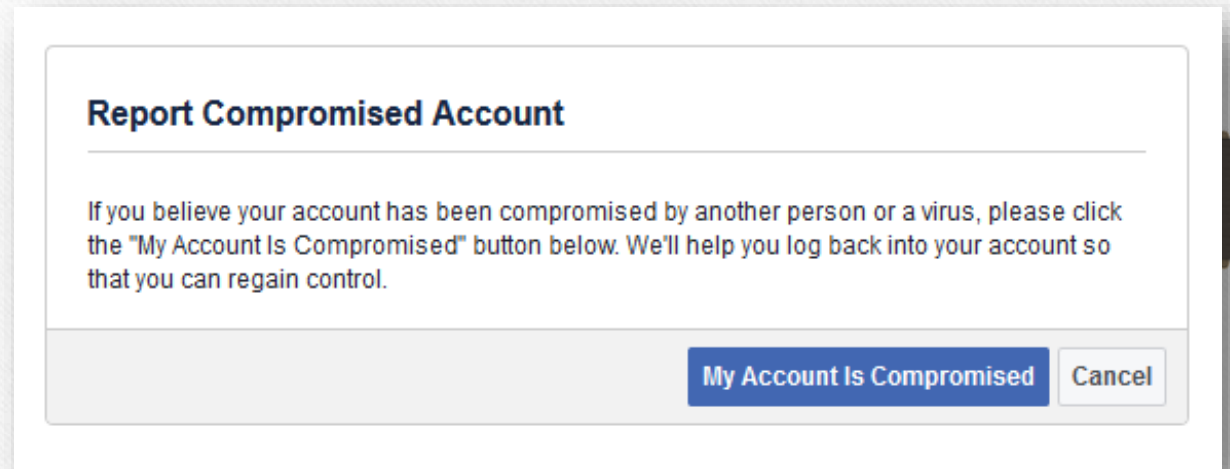
How to Prevent Being Hacked

- Create a strong password
- Check privacy settings
- Don't share too much information



What to do if your Facebook Account is Hacked?

- Report your account has been hacked.
- Login to your account to identify your account.
- Check to see if the hacker made any changes to your account.

Security Settings

Secure Browsing	Secure browsing is currently enabled.

Text Message (SMS) - Add Phone

Recovery Codes - Get Codes

Use these codes for when you don't have your phone with you, like when you're traveling.
